

# AFIKOMAN SQUAD PLATE

Simple Techniques - Stunning Effects



## **MATERIALS**

Coupe Dinner Plate
Fan Brush
Afikoman Pattern x2
NCR or tissue paper
Pen
Scissors
Dish for water
Straight Pin

## **COLORS**

CMM 88 - Vanilla Bean
CMM 12 - Mocha Java
CMM 15 - Mississippi Mud
CMM 98 - Red Head
CMM 11 - Blue Lagoon
CMM 62 - Just Blue



#### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut the square out of one of your paper patterns, don't worry about the rest yet.
- 2. We are going to paper paint the square. Apply a heavy amount of Vanilla Bean to the back of your square. Blob on some lines of Mocha Java before pressing the paper in the center of your plate. Don't worry about the paint that leaks out!
- 3. Use your fan brush and apply 3 coats of Blue Lagoon to the top of your plate. Go ahead and paint right on top of the paper.
- 4. Once the paint looses the shine, you can use the pin to remove the paper.
- 5. Use your NCR or tissue paper and transfer on the rest of your pattern.
- 6. To paint in the arms and the legs, use your liner or detail brush and Mocha Java, we did 2 heavy coats.
- 7. Paint in the shoes with Red Head using your detail brush, we will add the white in a later step.
- 8. We are going to use 3 heavy coats of Just Blue on the yamaka.
- 9. Next, use your detail brush to apply 2 heavy coats of Snowflake on the rest of the shoes, on the teeth, and you can start the lettering on the bottom while we wait for other things to dry.
- 10. Finally we are going to outline and add the star to the yamaka using our detail or liner brush.

### **TIPS**

- Make sure to apply a generous amount of paint to the back of the paper.
- Press the paper down, don't worry about the paint that leaks out!
- When you remove the paper, don't dig at the edge with the pin, it'll leave marks. Instead, poke in the middle and scoop upward.
- When applying the pattern, make sure the color underneath is dry.
- When outlining with a liner brush, hold the brush straight up and down to get thinner lines, and press down for thicker lines.
