MATERIALS

CCX066 Small Canister

Fan Brush Bunny Paper Pattern x2 NCR Paper Medium Brush Liner Brush Scissors Dish for water

COL ORS

CMM 16 - Chiffon CMM 47 - Deep Sea CMM 64 - Sky Blue CMM 67 - Snowflake CMM 31 - Licorice CMM 93 - London Fog CMM 44- Battleship CMM 55- Sea Mist CMM 69 - Carrot Juice CMM 21 - Mango Madness CMM 98 - Red Head

INSTRUCTIONS

1.Cut out one of the bunnies.

2.Paint one side of your jar with 1 coat of Snowflake using a fan brush. This will just be to give our paper something to stick to, so no stress.

3.Dip your paper bunny in the water dish and stick it on top of the section you painted with Snowflake.

4.Use a brush to smooth the paper down, then paint a coat of Snowflake on top to seal it down.

5.We are going to create a water colored background using shades of blue. First paint on two coats of Sky Blue all over the top of the lid and the outside of the canister.

6.Then dab on some Deep Sea and use a wet fan brush to brush over and soften it out.

7.Use a medium brush to splatter on some Deep Sea.

8.Use a pin to remove the paper pattern.

9.Paint on one coat of London Fog on the bunny avoiding the nose and inside the ears.


TIPS

- When applying the pattern, make sure the color underneath is dry.
- Press down firmly to make sure it's transferring.
- Always peel the paper back to make sure you've transferred before removing. When outlining with a liner brush, hold the brush straight up and down to get thinnner lines, and press down for thicker lines.
